

## Incyte Joins the Myeloproliferative Neoplasm (MPN) Community in Recognizing MPN Awareness Day and the 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Blood Cancer Awareness Month

WILMINGTON, Del. – Sept. 1, 2020 – Incyte is pleased to support the myeloproliferative neoplasm (MPN) community during the month of September in honor of the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Blood Cancer Awareness Month and MPN Awareness Day, which is recognized on September 10<sup>th</sup>. MPNs are a closely related group of rare, chronic blood cancers, which include myelofibrosis (MF), polycythemia vera (PV) and essential thrombocythemia (ET), affecting an estimated 200,000 people in the U.S.¹ They occur when the bone marrow that produces the body's blood cells functions abnormally.²

Throughout the month of September, Incyte is coordinating multiple activities to help raise awareness of MPNs and help people living with MPNs find the tools and resources necessary to better understand and navigate their disease.
